- ***Books:** Before the semester begins, set aside as much money as you can for the expenses of attending college, such as books, study supplies, or fuel for transportation to class. Required textbooks are listed on your printed schedule of classes. Payment is required at the time of placing a book order with the online bookstore. Chatfield College's online bookstore may buy back used books in good condition but many students utilize an informal network to locate used books for sale from classmates.
- If your expected aid award for a semester is greater than your tuition and fee charges your account will show an expected credit. In this case, a **book payment form** will be provided two weeks before classes begin. Financial aid must be fully completed to receive the form at this time. Otherwise the form is provided as financial aid is completed.
- **Credit Balances:** Any aid funds in excess of your tuition, fee and book charges may be issued directly to you for related educational expenses **after the actual funds are made available to the College and your account is paid in full.** Multiple payments may be made due to receipt of funding.
- **Student Payments:** Where expected aid funds are not sufficient to cover tuition and fees, you must arrange a payment plan with the Business Office for the balance **prior to the start of the semester.** No fees are charged for these payment plans, but interest may be charged if the plan is not followed and/or payment is not made. **If arrangements are not in place by the end of drop/add, you will be dropped from all classes.** Reinstatement is possible after satisfactory payment arrangements are made.
- **Loan and other aid payments to your account:** If you have taken a loan, any charges still unpaid at the time the loan funds arrive at the College will be paid from the loan. Please be aware that Federal and State grant funds may arrive at the College **after** loan funds do.
- **Adjustments:** If you change your class schedule during the drop/add period, your tuition charges and financial aid are adjusted. After the drop/add date, payment is required for all registered courses. All charges are based on the actual number of courses taken; Chatfield does not charge a flat fee for a particular range of credit hours.
