Dreaming about college? A new career? A job promotion? No matter what your dreams may be, Chatfield College can help you achieve them. We're known for our small classes, a family atmosphere that makes learning more enjoyable, and a caring faculty and staff that are committed to your success.

Chatfield's small classes (our student teacher ratio is just 5 to 1) allow for personal attention and a family-like atmosphere, which means you get more one-on-one guidance in a supportive environment!

Chatfield offers students a flexible schedule to accommodate individual needs. Each class meets just once a week so students are able to arrange their schedules around work or family responsibilities. And, you'll have a full range of both day and evening classes to choose from.

Chatfield has an open enrollment policy, which means the only requirement for admission is a high school diploma or a GED. ACT/SAT scores are not required.



Chatfield students come from a variety of backgrounds. Many of our students come to us immediately after they graduate from high school; others have been away from school for a number of years before they decide to attend college.

Chatfield is accredited by the Higher Learning Commission, **which means that** hours earned at Chatfield are transferable to four-year institutions, such as Xavier University, the University of Cincinnati, Northern Kentucky University, Wilmington College, the College of Mount St. Joseph, and many more.

Chatfield is a member of the Greater Cincinnati Consortium of Colleges and Universities. Full-time and part-time students at Chatfield are offered the opportunity to cross-register at one of the member institutions in a limited number of courses.

Academic Programs

The liberal arts course of study will introduce you to composition, math, the sciences, the arts, and philosophy. You will enhance your ability to read with comprehension in a number of areas, to do research, and to write academic papers. An expanding knowledge of the liberal arts will enable you to become a creative thinker who can analyze, synthesize, and creatively evaluate problems, ideas and solutions. In the process, you will also re-examine personal and ethical beliefs.

The Associate of Arts Degree

This general course of study will prepare you for a wide range of four-year programs. All students must complete 39 semester hours of general education core requirements as well as additional elective coursework specific to your chosen concentration.
