What an SWA does:

Under direct supervision, a Social Work Assistant may provide human, social, and community services that include:

- Assessment and referral;
- Screening, crisis intervention and resolution;
- Community support;
- Case management and outreach;
- Record keeping, social assessment;
- Visual observation of an individual in the individual's environment;
- Assistance in facilitation with groups and families;
- Advocacy, and orientation;
- Education, and prevention services.

Who may supervise the work of an SWA?

- A psychologist,
- A psychiatrist,
- A professional clinical counselor,
- A professional counselor,
- An independent social worker,
- A social worker,
- A registered nurse who holds a master's degree in psychiatric nursing.

Ohio SWA Requirements

- An Associate's Degree from an accredited college
- 30 semester credit hours of core social service/social work skills, theory, and systems courses including a social service practicum; and 14 semester credit hours of related courses such as psychology, sociology, and economics; and
- The applicant must have received a grade of at least a C- in all coursework.
